

HILLSDALE TRADITION AWARD
Requirements and Guidelines

Recipients must demonstrate financial need of at least half ($\frac{1}{2}$) the cost of education to continue to receive award.

Recipients must maintain a minimum 2.5 grade point average.

Recipients must agree to work on- or off-campus an average of eight (8) hours per week every semester while school is in session. Students opting to work off-campus must submit signed documentation from his/her employer each semester with an explanation of the average number of hours the recipient works per week.

Recipients must agree to volunteer an average of fifteen (15) hours per semester of community service in the greater Hillsdale area. Recipients may register at the G.O.A.L. office to sign-up for programs offered through that office to take part in community service working with the disadvantaged, the aged, and others less fortunate.

Recipients wishing to participate in volunteer programs other than those through the G.O.A.L. office must first get approval from the Director of Student Financial Aid to ensure that such community service is acceptable for the Hillsdale Tradition Award requirement.

Any disputes regarding time worked, hours of community service, and grade point requirement will be settled in the Office of Student Aid. Recipients with such problems should contact their financial aid counselor.

The Director of Student Financial Aid, who presides over any and all appeals, will make the final determination of all Hillsdale Tradition Award issues.
